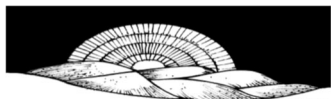
### MISSION STATEMENT/DECLARACIÓN DE MISIÓN

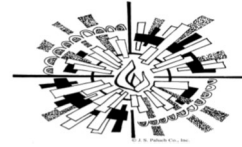
